HAZARD AWARENESS

“Site Prestart Hazard Analysis. It’s everyone’s business”

Yesterday we had a major injury to one of our employees on site. A simple slip due to no fault of the employee and an awkward landing resulted in surgery last night and a minimum 6 weeks out of action.

Initial investigations suggest that the blueboard section under the sliding door track was wet and contributed to our man slipping. He was not carrying any components at the time.

What this highlights is the critical importance of Site Hazard Identification each time you enter a site. The formal procedure for this task is part of our Site Pre Start Checklist.

EVERYONE NEEDS TO TAKE PART IN SITE PRESTART HAZARD IDENTIFICATION, EVERYTIME.

We don’t expect that you would identify a hazard such as this one every time but it does show how sometimes seemingly safe environments present hazards that may not be visible at first glance.
