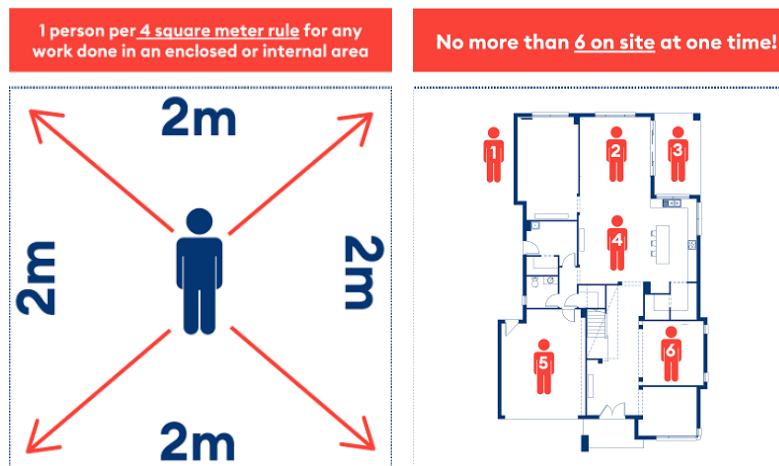
Safety ALERT

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY – ON ALL BUILDING sites in relation to COVID-19

To assist in ensuring that the residential building industry remains operational during this current crisis:

If you are unwell and showing cold and flu like symptoms, you must not come onsite.

If you are onsite and you start to feel ill - STOP WORK , LEAVE SITE , GO HOME , contact your Supervisor immediately & seek medical advice.



Keep a full arm span (about 1.5 or more) between yourself and other people. Avoid physical contact with each other. 1 person per 4 square meter rule for any work done in an enclosed or internal area

No more than 6 PERSONS on ONE site at one time. If other trades are onsite and they take the total above 6, ask them to relocate during the scaffold works. If they don't agree, ring Linc Office on 1300 70 2000 and wait for instructions. Do not start works on site.

Provide clear work zones and work stations for dedicated tasks.

Try to avoid car pooling. If it's critical, ensure social distancing criteria is met.

Anyone that is coming back from interstate or overseas is required to follow the 14 day self isolation policy.

The best way to keep adequate hygiene is for all team members to supply their own sanitizer or soap (tool of trade) and use running water provided onsite.

Wash or sanitize your hands regularly while onsite. Wash your hands before applying and adjusting your personal protective equipment.

Where reasonably practicable, avoid sharing tools or clean before and after use.

Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.

Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Dispose of the tissue straight away if you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve or elbow.
